## RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS – HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN’S BIRTHDAY FLYPAST REHEARSALS – 9 - 11 JUNE 2015

- 1** A large formation of military aircraft will form Her Majesty the Queen’s Birthday Flypast on 13 June 2015; rehearsals for this flypast will be held during the period **9-11 June 2015**. The rehearsals will start in the vicinity of Southwold, Suffolk then route via the overhead of RAF Marham, Norfolk and conclude, for dispersal, at RAF Waddington, Lincolnshire. Due to the large number of aircraft involved, the Secretary of State for Transport has decided that it is necessary to introduce the following Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009.

**NOTE: FOLLOWING A SUCCESSFUL REHEARSAL, SUBSEQUENT REHEARSAL DAYS WILL BE CANCELLED BY NOTAM.**

- (a) Subject to paragraph 1(d), between 1010 hours and 1200 hours on each day beginning with 9 June and ending on 11 June 2015, no aircraft is to fly below 10000 ft amsl within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following points: 525209N 0022026E - 523249N 0025026E - 522558N 0024447E - 520814N 0020909E - 520436N 0015041E - 522200N 0012000E - 525209N 0022026E.
- (b) Subject to paragraph 1(d), between 1135 hours and 1205 hours on each day beginning with 9 June and ending on 11 June 2015, no aircraft is to fly below 7000 ft amsl within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following points: 524111N 0003539E - 522600N 0012800E - 522230N 0012100E - 523636N 0003222E - 524111N 0003539E.
- (c) Subject to paragraph 1(d), between 1135 hours and 1215 hours on each day beginning with 9 June and ending on 11 June 2015, no aircraft is to fly below 3000 ft amsl within the area bounded by straight lines joining successively the following points: 531514N 0002624W - 530114N 0002114W - 524111N 0003539E - 523636N 0003222E - 530332N 0004246W - 531459N 0004230W - 531619N 0004034W, and then the anticlockwise arc of a circle having a radius of 5 nm whose centre is at 531828N 0003303W between 531619N 0004034W and 531514N 0002624W.
- (d) Paragraphs 1(a) to 1(c) do not apply to any aircraft flying:
  - (i) in accordance with a clearance issued by the Swanwick Mil, RAF Marham, RAF Waddington or RAF Cranwell;
  - (ii) in the service of the Maritime and Coastguard Agency; or
  - (iii) in accordance with a permission issued by the HQ AIR Queen’s Birthday Flypast 2015 Project Officer who may be contacted on Telephone: 07770-648637.

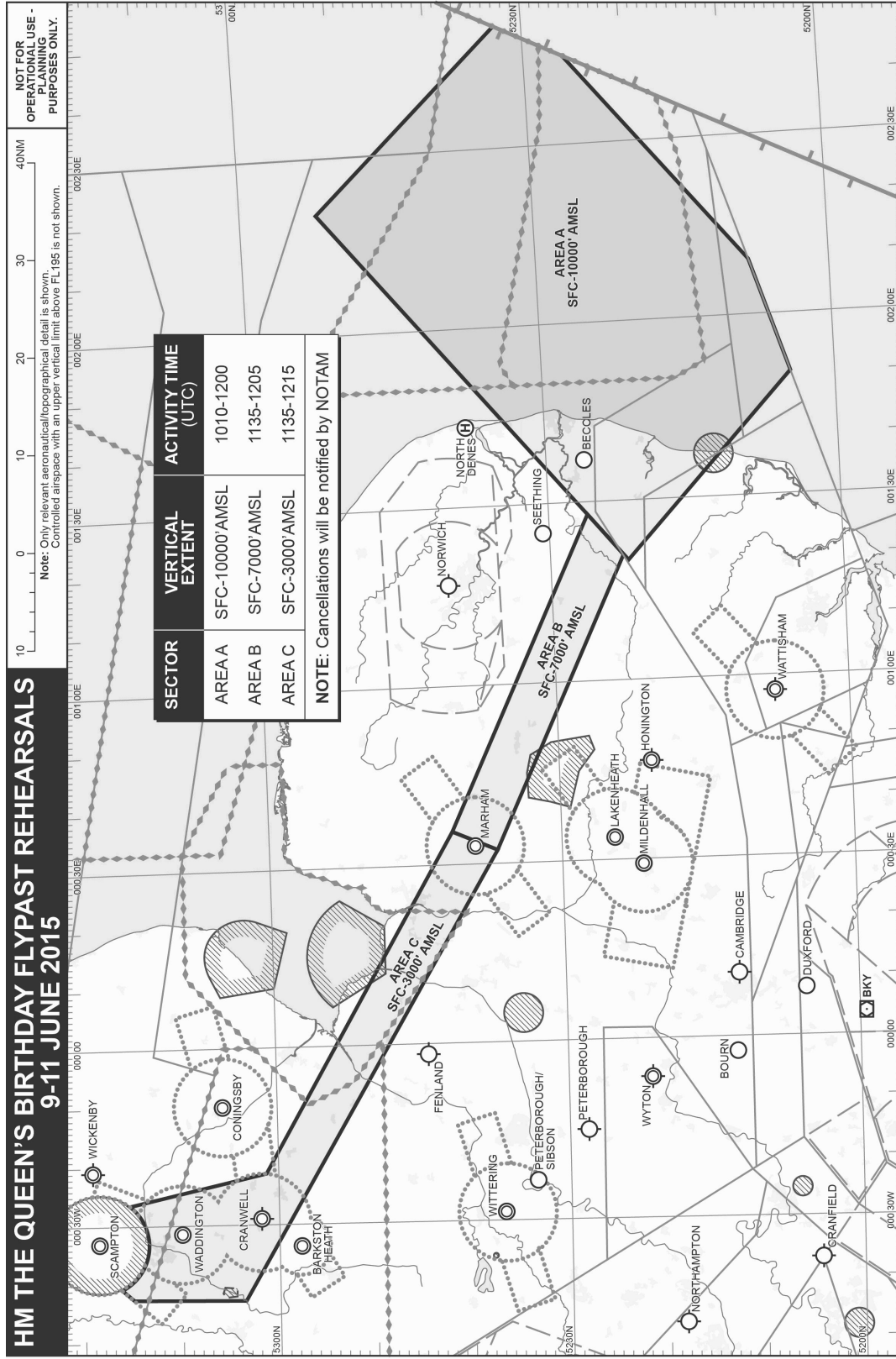
- 2** These Restricted Areas (Temporary) directly affect controlled airspace, a number of Aerodrome Traffic Zones and also aerodromes/flying sites that do not have Aerodrome Traffic Zones. Aerodrome Operators and ATS Units affected by the RA(T) are requested to bring this Circular to the attention of their resident and local operators.
